

BARBER COMBO HAIRCUT AND BEARD TRIM COMPETITION RULES

Eligibility

- **Open to all barbers and hairstylists, regardless of experience level.**
- **Each participant must provide a model for the competition.**

Hair and Beard Preparation

- **Models must have a minimum of 5 cm of hair on the top and at least 2 cm of beard growth prior to the competition.**
- **Hair and beard must be clean and dry at the start of the competition.**

Hairstyles Allowed

- **Side Part**
- **Combover**
- **Slick Back**

Tools Allowed

- **Hair clippers with guards, scissors, combs, trimmers, and straight razors.**
- **Blow dryers and styling tools for finishing touches.**
- **Hair and beard products such as pomades, oils, balms, and sprays for hold and finish.**
- **Prohibited: The use of colored sprays or temporary dyes during the competition.**

Time Limit

- **Each competitor has a strict time limit of 60 minutes to complete the haircut and beard trim.**

Execution

- **All haircuts must showcase a cohesive style that complements the beard trim, featuring precision in both the haircut and beard detailing.**
- **Creative modifications are permitted, but the fundamental integrity of the haircut and beard must be maintained.**

Presentation

- **Models should be dressed appropriately to enhance the overall look of the haircut and beard.**
- **Competitors must ensure that both the hair and beard are styled neatly, demonstrating a polished and professional finish.**

Judging Criteria

- **Judging will be based on the following criteria:**
 - **Technical Execution:** Precision and cleanliness of both the haircut and beard trim.
 - **Quality of Styling:** Definition and cohesiveness of the hairstyle and beard.
 - **Execution Time:** Adherence to the time limits set for the haircut and beard trim.
 - **Overall Appearance:** Coordination of the model's style, attire, and overall presentation.

Disqualifications

Participants may be disqualified for:

- **Any use of unauthorized tools or products.**
- **Exceeding the established time limit.**

FAST FADE HAIRCUT COMPETITION RULES

Eligibility

- **Open to all barbers and hairstylists, regardless of experience level.**
- **Each participant must provide a model for the competition.**

Hair Preparation

- **Models must any length of hair on the top and at least 1.5 cm on the sides and back prior to the competition.**
- **Hair must be clean and dry at the start of the competition.**
- **Top can be prepared before.**

Hairstyles Allowed

- **ALL**

Tools Allowed

- **Hair clippers with guards, scissors, combs, and blending shears.**
- **Blow dryers for styling, if required.**
- **Hair products such as pomades and sprays for finishing.**
- **Prohibited: The use of colored sprays or temporary dyes during the competition.**

Time Limit

- **Each competitor has a strict time limit of 20 minutes to complete the fade haircut.**

Execution

- **All haircuts must focus on delivering a smooth, blended fade that transitions seamlessly from short to long.**
- **The top length can be adjusted according to the style preference, but the focus should remain on the fade technique.**
- **Creative modifications to the fade style are permitted, but clarity and precision must be maintained.**

Presentation

- **Models should be dressed appropriately to complement the haircut and highlight the fade.**
- **Competitors must ensure that the hair is styled neatly, demonstrating a polished and professional finish.**

Judging Criteria

Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- **Technical Execution: Precision, cleanliness, and blending of the fade.**
- **Quality of Fade: Smoothness of the transitions and overall appearance of the haircut.**
- **Execution Time: Adherence to the time limits set for the haircut.**

- **Overall Appearance: Coordination of the model's style, attire, and overall presentation.**

- **Blow dryers and styling tools for finishing touches.**
- **Hair products such as texturizing sprays, pomades, and waxes for hold and finish.**
- **Prohibited: The use of colored sprays or temporary dyes during the competition.**

Time Limit

- **Each competitor has a strict time limit of 30 minutes to complete the haircut and styling.**

Execution

- **All haircuts must showcase a classic crop style, featuring a short, textured top and a tapered or faded finish on the sides.**
- **Creative modifications are permitted, but the fundamental crop shape must be adhered to.**

Presentation

- **Models should be dressed appropriately to complement the haircut.**
- **Competitors must ensure that the hair is styled neatly, demonstrating a polished and professional finish.**

Judging Criteria

Judging will be based on the following criteria:

1. **Technical Execution: Precision and cleanliness of the haircut.**
2. **Quality of Texture and Shape: Definition and style of the crop.**
3. **Execution Time: Adherence to the time limits set for the haircut and styling.**

4. **Overall Appearance: Coordination of the model's style, attire, and overall presentation.**

- **Any use of unauthorized tools or products.**
- **Exceeding the established time limit.**

POMPADOUR HAIRCUT COMPETITION RULES

Eligibility

Hair Preparation

- **Models must have a minimum of 10 cm of hair on the top, with at least 3 cm on the sides and back prior to the competition.**
- **Hair must be clean and dry at the start of the competition.**

Tools Allowed

- **Hair clippers with guards, scissors, combs, and thinning shears.**
- **Blow dryers and styling tools for finishing touches (e.g., flat irons).**
- **Hair products such as pomades, gels, and sprays for hold and finish.**
- **Prohibited: The use of colored sprays or temporary dyes during the competition.**

Time Limit

- **Each competitor has a strict time limit of 50 minutes to complete the pompadour haircut and 15 styling.**

Execution

- **All haircuts must showcase a classic pompadour style, featuring a voluminous and swept-back top with shorter sides and back.**
- **Creative modifications are permitted, but the fundamental pompadour shape must be adhered to, maintaining the height and volume of the top.**

Presentation

- **Models should be dressed appropriately to complement the pompadour style.**
- **Competitors must ensure that the hair is styled neatly, demonstrating a polished and professional finish.**

Judging Criteria

- **Judging will be based on the following criteria:**
 - **Technical Execution: Precision and cleanliness of the haircut.**
 - **Quality of Volume and Style: Definition and overall look of the pompadour.**

- **Execution Time: Adherence to the time limits set for the haircut and styling.**
- **Overall Appearance: Coordination of the model's style, attire, and overall presentation.**

Disqualifications

Participants may be disqualified for:

- **Any use of unauthorized tools or products.**
- **Exceeding the established time limit.**

Judging Panel

Awards
